Before you install this product clean the vehicle.

Model year 2014-2016

1

Put the motorcycle on a work stand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

2

Remove the fairing screw at the bottom.

3

Remove the lambda cable clip from the frame.

4

Remove the exup cable behind the rear brake fluid reservoir.

5

Be careful with the lambda and the exup cable. Loosen and move the silencer to the right.

6

Remove the shock absorber screws and the link screw from the swing arm.

7

Remove the original shock absorber downwards.

8

Install the Öhlins shock absorber.

9

Install all removed parts in the same positions that they were before removal.

👁 Note!

Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before you tighten the screws.

👋 Caution!

Make sure that you tighten all screws to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber/front fork/steering damper when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.

Model year 2017-

1

Put the motorcycle on a work stand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

2

Remove the fairing screw at the bottom.

3

Remove the plastig hugger in front of the rear wheel from the swing arm.

4

Remove the triangle link and pullrod from the swing arm, shock absorber and frame.

5

Remove the original shock absorber downwards.

6

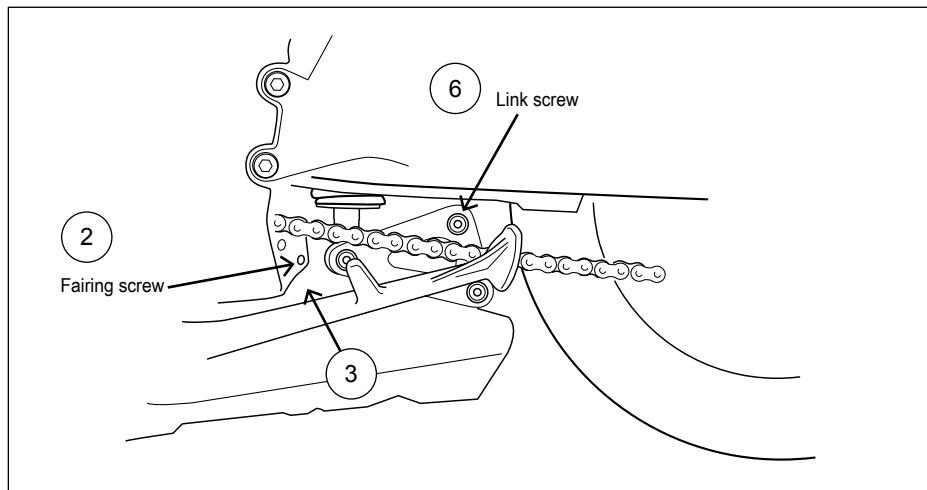
Install the Öhlins shock absorber.

7

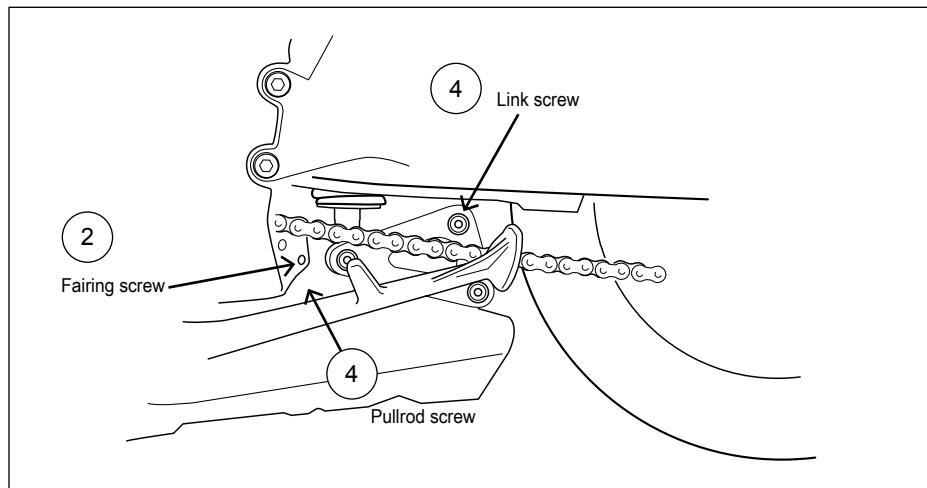
Install all removed parts in the same positions that they were before removal.

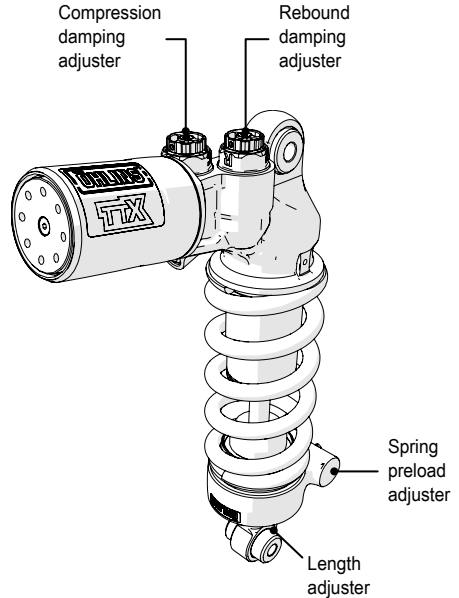
