MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

We strongly recommend to let an Öhlins dealer install this product.

If you work with a lifted vehicle, make sure that it is safely supported to prevent it from tipping over.

Note!

When you work with this product, see the vehicle service manual for vehicle specific procedures and important data.

Note!

Before you install this product clean the vehicle.

1

Put the motorcycle on a work stand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

2

Remove the panels below the handle bars, up to the dashboard, on left and right hand side.

3

Remove the passenger and rider seats.

4

Remove the panels below the tank.

5

Remove the panel screws.

6


Flex the side fairings out carefully, to access the screws holding the tank. Remove these screws and the ones in the front and back of the tank.


7

Lift the tank upwards a little to be able to disconnect hoses and wires. Then remove the tank

Remove the big nut at the upper shock absorber mounting.

Remove the std spring preload adjuster together with its bracket.

10

Remove the lower shock absorber screw and pull out the shock absorber.


Move the clevis from the std shock absorber to the Öhlins.



Mount everything back in reverse order.

Note!


Check that the preload adjuster hose has smooth bends and use supplied Tie-raps to fasten it.
